Public Meeting - Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments

TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Stone Mills is considering the adoption of an Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment to amend Comprehensive Zoning By-law No. 2014-744, as amended. Pursuant to Sections 17(17) and 34(13) of the *Planning Act* (R.S.O. 1990), Council will hold a public meeting on **Mon day, June 24th, 2024 at 5:00 pm** within Council Chambers at the municipal offices located at 4504 County R oad 4, Centreville, to outline the content and effect of the applications. All those interested are hereby invited t o attend the public meeting and express their view on the applications.

Purpose and Effect of the Proposed Amendments

The Township of Stone Mills is proposing amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law for the purpose of protecting agricultural lands throughout the Township. Some members of the community have expressed con cern regarding the number of severances and potentially incompatible development occurring on lands that are a ctively used for agricultural purposes (or are capable of being used for agricultural purposes) and the future im pacts this may have on the agricultural economy in the Township of Stone Mills.

The Official Plan Amendment contemplates the introduction of a site-specific policy area that would apply to t he lands identified in the Canada Land Inventory (CLI) as Class 1 - 3 soils but that are not designated 'Agricultu ral' in the Township's Official Plan. Lands within proposed overlay area would be subject to an additional set o f policy criteria respecting lot creation, including:

- requirements to limit lot size to be no larger than needed;
- consideration for other more suitable locations on the same lot;
- requirement for an Agricultural Impact Assessment (AIA) to demonstrate compatibility where warrante d; and
- requirements for mitigation measures implemented via zoning regulation.

To implement the above noted policy changes and to provide restrictions on residential development on existing lots of record, changes to the Township's Comprehensive Zoning By-law are also proposed via the introduction of a Rural Agricultural 'RAG" zone. The Zoning By-law Amendment proposes to introduce a new maximum l ot size requirement for new residential lot creation in these areas and to establish new maximum yard requirem

ents for residential uses on existing lots of record. These changes will restrict the residential building envelope on existing lots of record on Class 1-3 soils and limit the size of new residential lots that can be created via the consent process.

The purpose of this public meeting is to solicit public input from the broader community. No decisions will be made by Council at this meeting. This meeting is in addition to the May 6, 2024 public meeting that garnered in itial input and feedback from ratepayers.

Location

The subject lands associated with the proposed amendments include all lands identified in the Canada Land Inve ntory (CLI) as Class 1 - 3 soils throughout the Township of Stone Mills. See Key Map.

Representation and Information

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of Township of Stone Mills C ouncil to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a p ublic meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Stone Mills before the by-laws are passed, the pe rson or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to t he Township of Stone Mills before the by-laws are passed, the person or public body may not be added as a part y to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are re asonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
